FUTURE TRIPS

March 11-17 - Seattle, Washington: Working in conjunction with Matthew Savage UBC will support the ministry efforts of his church by reaching into the community with support for children's programs and local ministry programs. Contact the Student Ministries Office for additional information. Approximate cost: \$600.

April 27 – 29 ~ Mexico Vine and Branches Ministry: UBC missionaries will serve during *Children's Day Festival (Dia de los Ninos)* in Piedras Negras, Mexico. This weekend trip will coordinate with the International Soccer Ministry and work with children in the village. Cost: \$150.

June 1-8 – Tegucigalpa, Honduras: This trip will serve the people of Honduras with medical missions. Medical experience not necessary. Approximate cost: \$1500.

June 22-30 - Navajo Reservation: UBC will build a church building, train church leaders, work with children in VBS, and work with students in sports camps. Contact the Discipleship Office for additional information. Approximate cost: \$700.

July 18-30 - Port Shepstone, KwaZulu- Natal South Africa: Missionaries will work with Genesis Trust (the outreach arm of Norwegian Settlers Church), help serve the community by meeting physical, social and spiritual needs associated with HIV/AIDS, poverty and other social issues. We will work in schools teaching life skills and local orphanages communicating the Gospel of Jesus in a multitude of ways. Contact the Student Ministries Office for additional information. Approximate cost: \$3300.

July 18 – 25 - Dominican Republic: UBC Women will train and encourage Christian teachers of underprivileged children, work and play with children in a Christian orphanage and provide needed teaching materials to be used in the schools & orphanage. There will be time for personal renewal as well. Contact Karol Peters or Lora Doremus for additional information. Approximate cost: \$1500.

July 26–August 14 - London: Join teams to make the most of the Olympic games in London. Around the period of the Olympic Games, we will construct a set of marquees in a large green space in middle of Chalfont St. Peter. This will be the main location from which we will run a variety of different activities for babies, children, youth and adults, run a hospitality tent for parents, and in the evening show live Olympic events on big screens as well as other sporting, cultural and outreach events. During the weekends we will be organizing sporting events and tournaments. On Sundays there will be large celebration worship services, and services to mark the closing and opening ceremonies of the Olympic Games. Contact Jason Gadman for additional information. August 18-25 - Living Water International, Nicaragua: UBC's Living Water International team will drill a well for a village in Nicaragua. (If you are on Facebook, look for "University Baptist Church Living Water Trip" group page.) Contact the Discipleship Office for additional information. Approximate Cost: \$1700.

October 6 – 20 - Thailand: Discipleship and follow up with believers, churches and orphanages from previous trips. Approximate Cost: \$3000.

Mission Trips in the Works (Contact the Discipleship Office for additional information)

- Ecuador, Quito – work with the Larry and Amanda Castro with general evangelism and radio ministry.
- Haiti – Help with school facility and children, and work with a church plant.
- Indonesia - work with village development, micro business development, and care for orphans.
- Mexico - Piedras Negras - work with soccer teams, work with children in the study program, feed children. Spring trip and summer trip.
- USA, Long Island – Crossroads Church in Long Island (Sterling Edwards) is in need of summer residents and help with a new church plant. August
- USA, Seattle – Journey Church (Matthew Savage) is preparing for UBCers to work during spring break and a follow up trip in the summer. July
